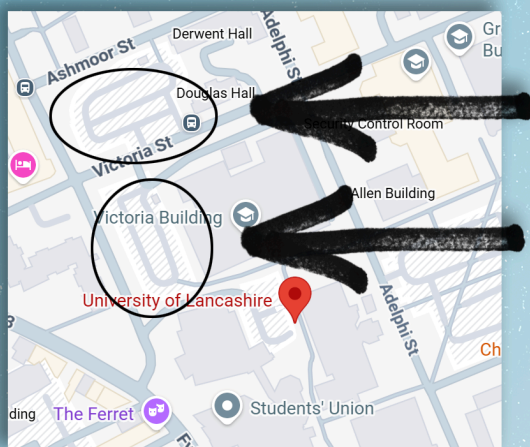
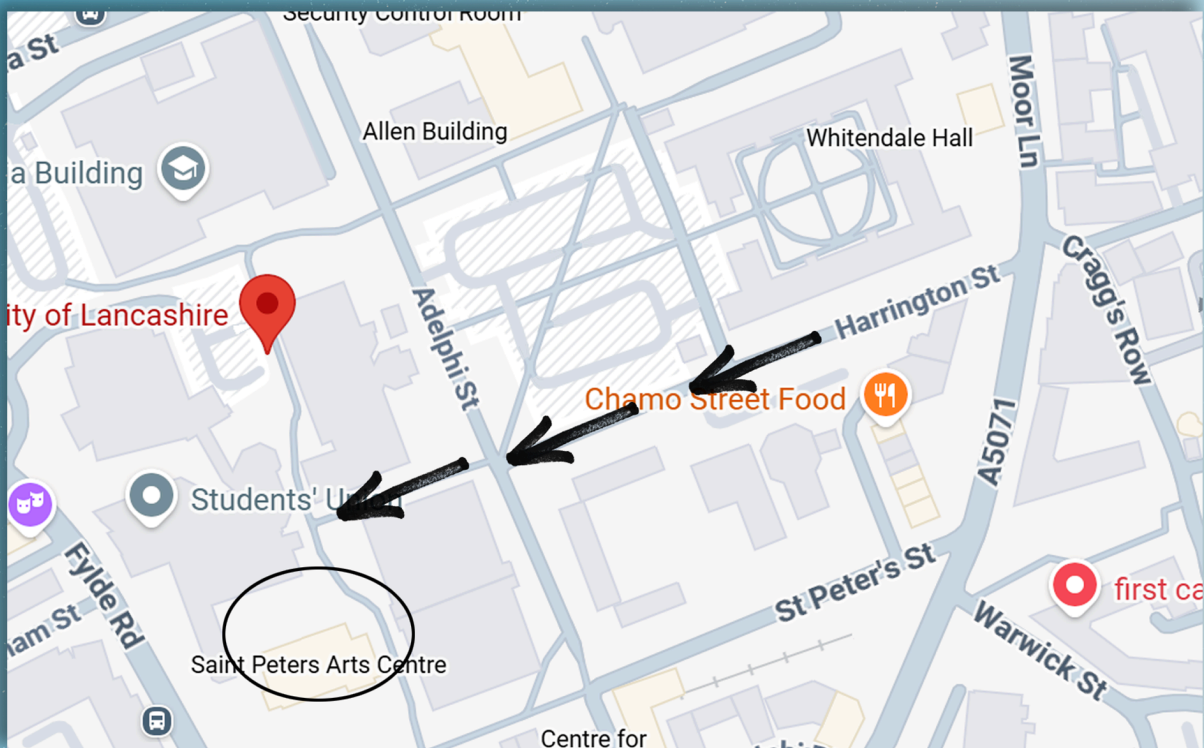

## VENDOR INFORMATION

### VENDOR LOAD-IN/LOAD-OUT

Vendors can begin to load-in to The Atrium from 0800. Please be set-up and ready for 0945 - attendees will gain access at 1000. Vehicles can be parked on ST PETERS SQUARE for load-in, what3words ///normal.adopt.pipe. Access is off Moor Lane, turning onto Harrington Street and crossing Adelphi Street to The Atrium. Following load-in, vendor vehicles need to be parked in Victoria, Victoria 2 or Flyde car park. It will be the same script for load-out. Vendors can relocate their vehicles to St Peter's Square. Be mindful of your speed when exiting onto St Peter's Square and park sensibly. Stewards will be available in high-vis jackets directing vehicles. The event will be finishing at 1600, with last attendee access being at 1530.



### **VICTORIA AND VICTORIA 2 CAR PARKS**

Access is gained by turning left back onto Adelphi street and taking a left onto Victoria Street at the traffic lights.

The car parks will be on your left and right respectively. It is only a short walk back to the Atrium, with the 'path of least resistance' through Victoria car park and turning left at the front of the Victoria building.

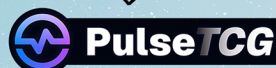
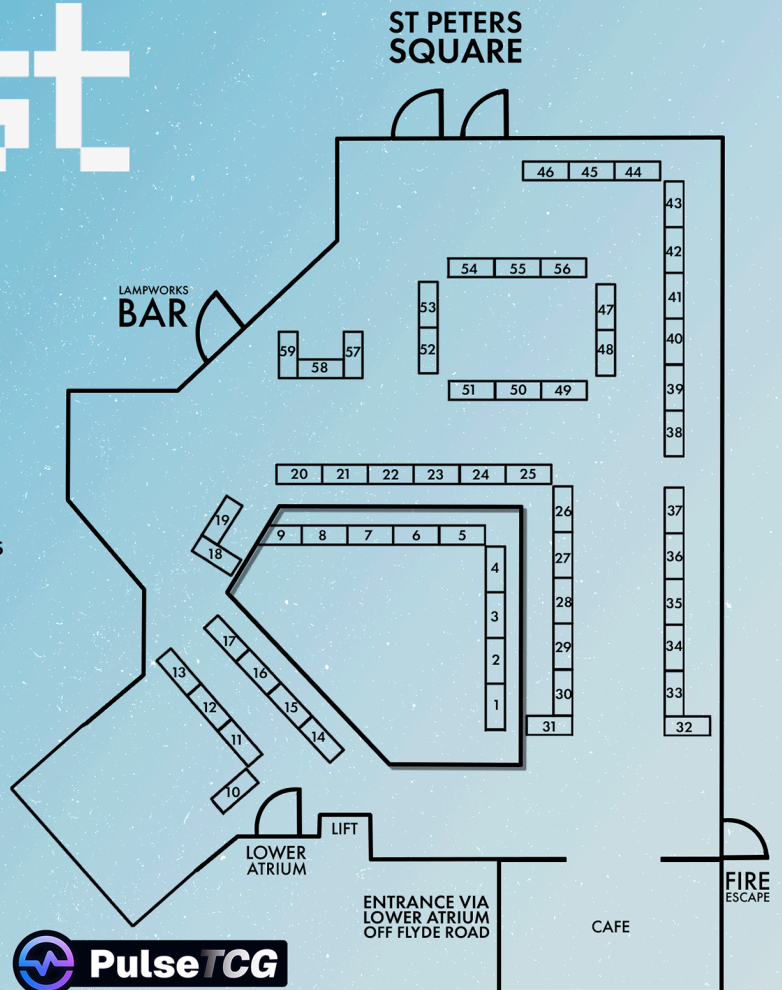

The floor plan is not to scale. Every attempt has been made to produce an accurate representation of the area. As such, the aisle space between tables 10 - 13 and 14 - 17 measures at 2.5m. Likewise, the area behind 10 - 13 extends further back.

It is our intention to utilise the space across from 18 - 19, but with a fire door in the top left corner, we need to ensure that we do not encroach on egress whilst also ensuring that the vendor in that area has suitable space to operate.

Finally, we hoped to utilise the wall space leading up from the Lampworks door - St Peters Square. However, there is currently a reception desk here that we believed would be moved. We are going to see what is in the art of possible on the day and open up that space for vendors. If you see something that will work on the day when you are loading in, please let us know!

## VENDOR INFORMATION

We have attempted to make the layout as accessible as possible. Due to a few last minute injects from UCLAN and the lack of ability to move various items of furniture that we believed would be moved for us, we have had to allocate across the two floors.

The flow of attendees through the venue will provide ample opportunity for all vendors, and allocation of tables on the 1st floor of the Atrium was decided by vendor sign up dates.

Attendees will enter the lower atrium through the main doors, with the standard flow passing all nine tables before heading upstairs into the upper atrium. Access in the first hour will be completed in waves to minimise overcrowding. There may be some adjustments to the layout on the day once all the tables are in place, but this will not be detrimental to the overall vendor experience.

Whilst creating this document, the event was close to selling out. We anticipate a large interest during the day from walk-ins. As such, please be mindful of your stock and if possible, ensure that you have two members of staff per table for enhanced vigilance. UCLAN security and Card Fest staff will have an active presence, so if you have any concerns, please raise it with us. If you are solo and need a break, please message Ben on WhatsApp. I will be more than happy to stand at your table whilst you have a break. Likewise, if you require any food or drinks picking up - we can also assist with that.

If you have shelving and are located within the inner wall of the atrium, please be mindful of the height of such shelving and what you are stocking higher up. We will have netting in place to counteract any merchandise falls from the upper atrium, but please be mindful of this during your set up.

The Lampworks - accessible from the Atrium - will be open throughout the day. Lampworks serves a selection of hot food, soft and alcoholic drinks and bar snacks. It is a large area for people to unwind and relax. Furthermore, the cafe within the atrium will be open selling a selection of hot and cold food and coffee.

This is our first event and our plan is to run Card Fest twice a year - April and October. As such, we are always looking at ways we can improve the show for both vendors and attendees. We are under no illusion that the show is not going to be perfect at the first iteration, and it is only with constructive feedback that we can continue growing the show - making it bigger, better and more inclusive with each iteration. If you see any quick fixes on the day, please let us know and we will try our best to incorporate them straight away. Likewise, any other feedback, we are all ears.

Pulse TCG is a web-based application that allows vendors to quickly and accurately comp prices, add the associated cards to a deal interface to effectively track your deal, and work out the trade/cash percentages. Please provide your own 6ft x 2ft table cloths. We have attempted to purchase branded table cloths for the event, but these are only going to be available from October onwards. We do have a small collection of tablecloths to hand, so if you do not own any - please let me know. You can get inexpensive 6ft x 2ft table cloths on Amazon.

Bin bags will be provided to all vendors. Please dispose on your rubbish accordingly and keep all walk ways clear. Staff will be routinely walking the hall, so if you require your bin bag replacing, let us know and we can dispose of it accordingly.

## FIRE SAFETY & EMERGENCY EVACUATION

In the event of a fire alarm, please remain calm and follow the instructions of event staff.

Fire exits are clearly marked throughout the venue. Please locate your closest fire exit upon arrival.

Do not use the lift during evacuation.

If you discover a fire, activate the nearest alarm and alert a member of staff immediately.

Assemble on St Peters Square and do not re-enter the building until given permission by emergency personnel.

First aid support is available on site. If you require assistance, please inform a member of staff. The designated first aid location is the check-in desk located in the lower atrium.

CCTV will be in operation, but Card Fest cannot accept liability for lost or stolen items. If you notice any suspicious activity, please report it to a member of staff or security immediately.
